Associate Manufacture Supplier (AMS) Category Definition

Any person, firm or corporation which manufactures, supplies, sells or distributes materials or devices whose end use is intended for fire protection systems is eligible for Associate Manufacturer/Supplier Membership, provided they are not eligible for any Voting Membership categories, which are installing contractor categories.

All applications for membership must be approved by the Board of Directors.

There are three Board Meetings each year, generally in March, June and November. The board has set a precedent to reject any application which has not been completed in full.

A cheque must accompany the application.
